The City Council of the City of Piedmont met in special session at the time and on the date above. Present were Mayor Baker, Council Members John Lawrence, Greg South, David Ivey, and Terry Kiser.

Richard Williams, Jubal Feazell, and Caleb Pope were absent from the meeting.

The Mayor declared a quorum present and called the meeting to order.

The Mayor asked for consideration of Resolution 2025-26 which would be a canvassing of the votes for the 2025 Municipal Election for Mayor and Council. The official votes will be attached to the minutes of this meeting. Terry Kiser made a motion to adopt Resolution 2025-26. David Ivey seconded the motion and Resolution 2025-26 was adopted unanimously.

With no other business to come before the Council, Greg South made the motion that the meeting be adjourned. Terry Kiser seconded the motion and the meeting adjourned at 12:03 pm.

RESOLUTION 2025-26

WHEREAS, the general election for the City of Piedmont, Alabama, was duly and legally held on August 26, 2025, as provided by law, and;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Piedmont met on the 2nd day of September 2025, a quorum thereof being present, at 12:00 pm, and has canvassed the returns, and ascertained and determined the number of votes received by each candidate, and;

WHEREAS, the said municipal governing body has ascertained and determined the result of said follows:

1. That Kevin Farmer had no opposition in the office of the Mayor and will take office on the first Monday in November 2025.
2. That no candidate received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Councilmember, District 1, and that Brittney Williams and Robert Dunbar received the most and second most votes cast for that office. Therefore, a runoff election between said candidates is hereby ordered to be held on Tuesday, September 23rd, 2025, pursuant to the requirements of Section 11-46-20 et seq. of the Code of Alabama 1975, as amended.
3. That Kevin McCord had no opposition in District 2 and will take office on the first Monday in November 2025.
4. That Frank Cobb had no opposition in District 3 and will take office on the first Monday in November 2025.
5. That Mark Epps received the majority of the votes cast for the office of Councilmember District 4, and is hereby declared duly elected to that office for the term beginning on the first Monday in November 2025.
6. That Greg South received the majority of the votes cast for the office of Councilmember District 5, and is hereby declared duly elected to that office for the term beginning on the first Monday in November 2025.
7. That Carlos Farmer had no opposition in District 6 and will take office on the first Monday in November 2025.
8. That Matt Rogers had no opposition in District 7 and will take office on the first Monday in November 2025.
